RUBIE is a Retired Justice of the Supreme Court of The Commonwealth of The Bahamas (Family Division), and is currently an Associate Professor, Law Department, University of The Bahamas where she has lectured in ADR, Mediation and Arbitration in the UWI-LLB Law Programme. She is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, UK, a founding member of the CIArb, Bahamas Branch, and a former Director of Education and Training for the CIArb Bahamas Branch. She is a CIArb Approved Faculty member and an accredited CIArb Mediation Assessor/Moderator.

Justice Nottage is also one of three Bahamian appointees who sit on the World Bank's ICSID Panel of Conciliators and Arbitrators. She has attended training courses in Family Mediation (T&T), FIDIC (ECV Module 2), Wealth Management (BIFS, Bahamas), and holds a Post-Graduate Diploma (PGDip) in International Commercial Arbitration (Centre for Commercial Law Studies) Queen Mary, University of London, with a specialty in International Trade and Investment Dispute Settlement.

Justice Nottage has acted both solely and jointly with arbitrators of international repute in a variety of arbitrations ranging from construction disputes, public roadworks contracts, mortgage corporation and private condominium owners' disputes. Her vision is of a Bahamas recognized world-wide for its talented and experienced pool of Arbitrators and Conciliators working both domestically and internationally.
